

Literacy Development

- Read the story 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle. If you don't have a copy of the book, you can watch the animated film online

- Think about the activities we completed last week linked to vegetables. Look through the pictures in your book and talk about fruit. What fruit is your favourite? Can you make a fruit themed shopping list for your next trip to the shops?

- Talk to your child about the days of the week. In Nursery, we sing a 'Days of the Week' song every morning/afternoon. Ask your child to sing this to you.

"We are singing, we are singing, the days of the week, the days of the week, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, time to play". We sing this to the theme of Frère Jacques

Mathematical Development

- Explore the pages in the story where the hungry caterpillar eats through 1 apple, 2 pears etc. Encourage your child to count the fruit, pointing to each picture as they count.

- Have a go at making your very own hungry caterpillar picture using circle shapes.

- Take a look around your home, can you find something that is a circle shape? Take a photograph or draw it in your home learning book.
