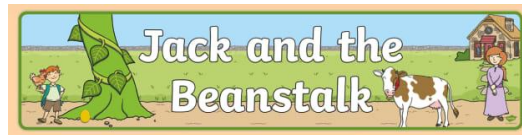


Literacy Development

- With your child, read the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. You could use a copy of the story that you have at home or take a look at the one I have uploaded on the class page. (You could also watch an animated version of the story online!)
- Talk about what happens in the story. Ask questions such as; "what happened at the start of the story?" "What is your favourite part of the story?" "Who is your favourite character from the story? Why?"
- Encourage your child to draw a picture that shows their favourite part of the story. If they are really interested, why not ask them to make their own character drawings that could be popped on to a stick to use for re-telling.



Mathematical Development

- Explore measurement at home this week. In the story, Jack meets a giant. What does giant mean? Talk about how the giant is much bigger than Jack. Can your child find something that is smaller/bigger than them? Tweet me some photographs of the things that you find.
