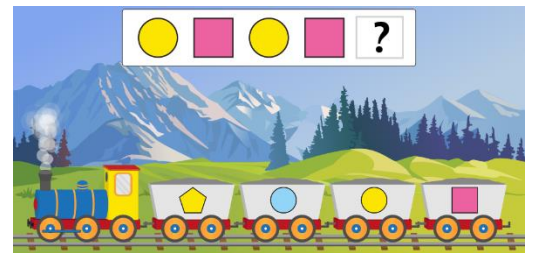


- Encourage your child to draw a picture for the NHS thanking them for the amazing job that they are doing by keeping us safe and looking after people who are poorly at this time.
