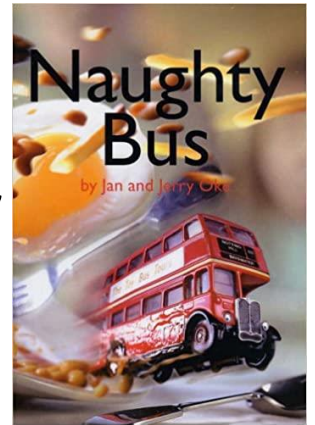


Literacy Development

- This week, we want you to explore the story 'Naughty Bus' by Jan and Jerry Oke. If you don't have a copy at home, you can watch it being read on YouTube <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WST-B8zQleM>
- After reading or watching 'Naughty Bus' talk with your child about the word 'naughty' - *What did the bus do that was naughty?* I know that sometimes we all make the wrong choices so encourage your child to think about what the bus could do to make things right again.
- Talk to your child about their favourite part of the story. Was it when he zoomed through the beans? Or was lifted out of the pond? Could it be when he had a wash? Or when he was tucked up tight in bed. Have a go at recreating your favourite part and share a picture with me on Twitter!
