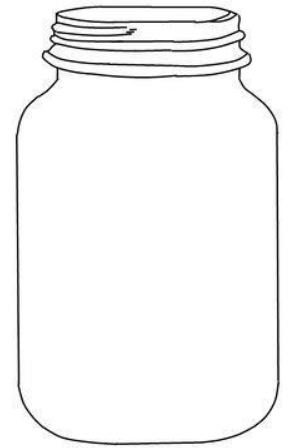


Literacy Development

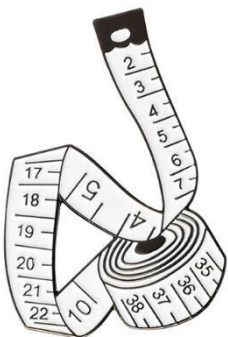
