

Literacy Development

- This week, let's explore the story 'Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you see?' by Bill Martin Jr and Eric Carle. You can find the story being read aloud on YouTube <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WST-B8zQleM>
- In the story, as you turn the page, the animals each talk about the different coloured animals that they can see. Talk to your child about which animal is their favourite and why?
- Ask your child to have a go at drawing their favourite animal and using the correct colour to colour it in. If they are feeling up for a challenge...Can they create a new character to add to this story? Such as; a pink flamingo, a green dinosaur etc.



Mathematical Development



As we are exploring colour, if you have any paint at home, let your child paint their hands to create some rainbow handprint flashcards similar to these.

← (If you don't have any paint, you could draw around your child's hands and let them colour their hand templates in different colours!)

- Use these flashcards around your home to help your child recognise that they can use their fingers to represent number all the way up to 10!
