

Communication & Language

Together read the 'We Are All Different' story PowerPoint (download from our class page). Spend time talking to your child about the pictures in this PowerPoint. Notice that everyone is different and we should celebrate our differences. We are all friends.

Personal, Social & Emotional

Play a game of 'Guess Who' with your family members. An adult could go first to model how to play this game. "This person has ... eyes and ... hair etc.

Ask your child to talk to you about what they like and dislike. Extend this question by asking your child why they do or do not like something.
