- As we are thinking about our local area this week, we would like you to draw a picture of your favourite place. Think about what it looks like, what colours will you need to use?



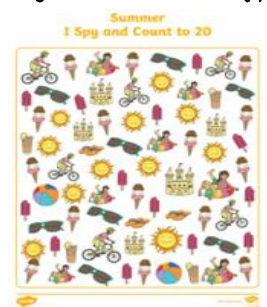
- Reception, have a go at writing a sentence about your favourite place. Why do you like this place? Who do you go there with? Nursery, talk about your favourite place.
