P.E.

PE is on Mondays and Thursdays. Please ensure children come to school wearing their full kit.

Maths

The key message for our learners is 'slow down to go fast' so during the summer term we are going to learn and relearn the fundamentals. We will cover the following: place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. There will be a focus on learning our number facts and times tables. During this term, we will learn how to estimate, calculate, perform the inverse, use units of measurement and complete missing box questions. Problem solving and open-ended investigations are also taught during our maths lessons.

Design and Technology

The focus will be Cams in which we will make a moving Victorian toy.

We are scientists

We will study 'Animals including humans'. We will understand the different parts of the digestive system in humans and animals. We will also learn about types and functions of teeth and tooth decay.

English

We will cover Fiction and Non-Fiction work on 'Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo and 'Billy's New Frock' by Anne Fine through which work on guided reading, comprehension and writing will be covered.

Spellings from the Year 4 statutory spellings list and spelling rules will be taught and sent as homework every week. Please make sure your child learns their spellings for their weekly spelling test and upload their spelling homework on Microsoft TEAMS every week.

Computing

During this term we will be learning about writing for different audiences. We will learn about how font size and style can affect the impact of a text; to use a simulated scenario to produce a news report and write for a community

campaign. 

Geography

This term, we will conduct Fieldwork. We will study Europe and compare geographical similarities and differences between a region in UK and Europe.

We are historians

During this term, we will study the 'Victorians' as part of our local history. We will compare children's lives during the Victorian period to modern times, including schooling. We will explore Victorian inventions and their impact on Britain today.

This term we will use the Wow room to stimulate learning in English, geography and history lessons. Children will enhance their imagination in this stimulating environment.

All children are expected to use TT Rockstars and read daily at home to an adult. Spellings and Times tables will be sent home every Monday for a test the following week. Spellings homework (sentences) and a Quiz must be uploaded on Microsoft Teams weekly.

Religious Education

This term, in our topic 'New Life/ Pentecost', we will learn about how good news brings life and how the new life of the Easter message is spread through the power of the Holy Spirit.

We will next study the topic 'Building Bridges' of friendship and understand importance of admitting wrong and being reconciled with God and one another. In our final topic 'God's People' we will learn about the life of Archbishop Oscar Romero and explore what makes someone extraordinary.



P.S.H.E

In the topic 'Relationships', we will identify the web of relationships we are part of and express why someone we love are special to us. We will also look at memories of people we no longer see. In our next topic 'Changing Me', we will appreciate being unique individuals and explore how the circle of change works. We will identify changes outside of our control and learn to accept them. Looking ahead to Year 5, we will reflect on changes we would like to make.
